

SUPPORTING HOUSING

Through our subsidiary organisations, YWCA National Housing and YWCA Housing, we support women in vulnerable situations with housing and homelessness support services.

We create innovative housing solutions for the growing number of older Australian women experiencing homelessness and housing unaffordability, who have often experienced domestic and family violence.

DEVELOPING LEADERS

We run leadership and mentoring programs, including a mentoring program for young women in the child protection system, leadership coaching for young women and culturally-aware leadership programs for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander women.
