Modern slavery disproportionately impacts women and gender diverse people globally. Raising awareness and taking action in this area reflects YWCA's commitment to gender equality.

To strengthen our approach, we are actively reviewing and updating our policies, procedures, and practices to ensure we prevent, identify, mitigate, and remediate modern slavery risks across our operations and supply chains.
